This letter provides the detailed breakdown of the fringes that contributing contractors are obligated to pay based on full hours effective June 5, 2017 to May 31, 2020. We have attached a reproduction of pages from the National Pipeline Agreement illustrating the same rates and how the health and welfare and pension rates will be reciprocated from the Pipeline Industry Benefit Fund to other local union funds.
